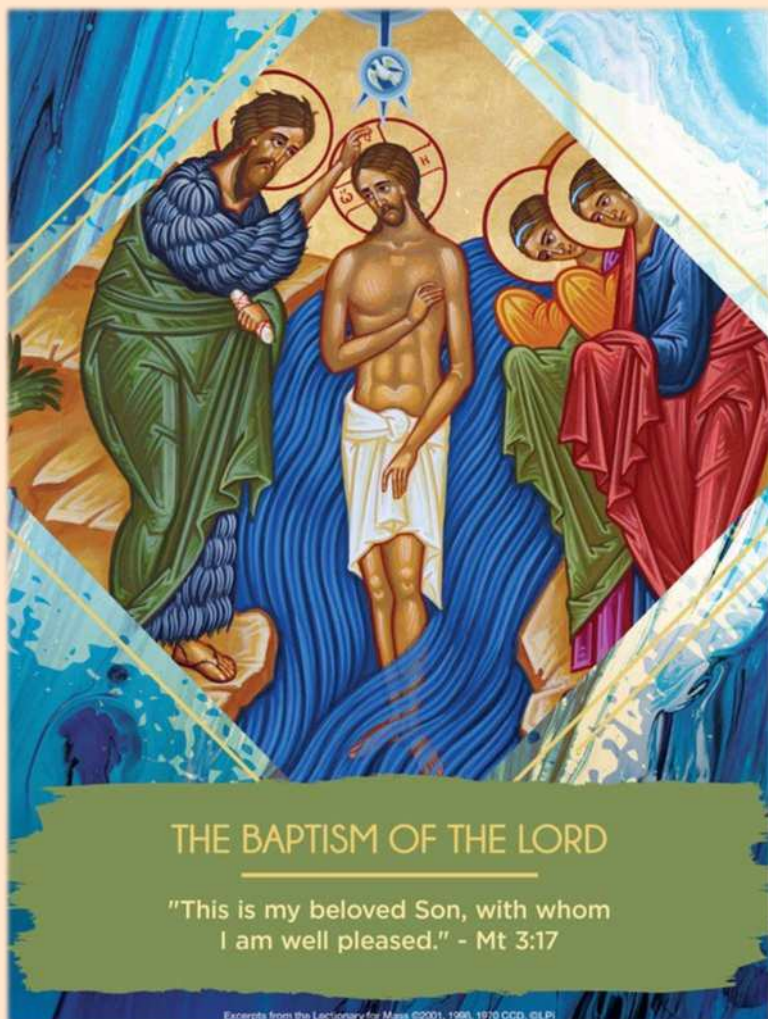

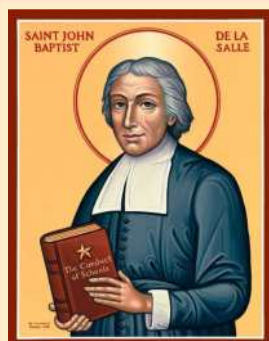

Make the connection

In his birth (Christmas), his adoration by the Magi (Epiphany), and the coming of the Spirit upon him (Baptism of the Lord) Jesus is revealed to be the Son of God. These significant events in Jesus' life are so closely tied that the Eastern Orthodox Church observes the coming of the Magi and the Lord's Baptism on the same day. In the same way, our own births and Baptism signal that we are children of God and followers of Christ. As a new year begins, find ways to reconnect with your family of faith and make daily choices that reveal your divine heritage.

Listen up

The tech industry would have us believe that the most important connections we make are virtual. While it's true that tech devices are useful in today's world, there remains the crucial connection with that still, small voice within our own hearts that no computer or phone can reach. That voice, which is God's, can only be heard in stillness: in the bare branches of trees against a winter sky, the quiet of new-fallen snow, the starry brilliance in a winter night sky, our breathing in and breathing out. What is God calling you to do now? Spend some time today just listening.

"I was a stranger"

Of all the lessons Jesus tried to teach us, the one that is perhaps hardest to believe—and therefore easiest to forget—is that we are all one. Jesus reminded us of this truth a number of times, most notably when he declared, "Just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me" (Matt. 25:40). Take a few minutes today to reflect on what life would be like if you knew, with as much certainty as you know your own name, that there are no strangers among us; we are all one, united through Christ. What would be different? How would you act toward yourself? Toward others?

Now appearing

You don't have to look very hard into Catholic tradition to find stories of supernatural appearances of Jesus, the saints, and especially Mary to believers through the centuries. These kinds of occurrences really go back to biblical times. In the New Testament the Holy Spirit "appeared" in the form of a dove at Jesus' Baptism, Jesus himself appeared to his disciples after his Resurrection, and the risen Christ made a decisive personal intervention in the life of Saint Paul, to name a few examples. Most of us will never have such an experience, but we can indeed learn to make ourselves aware of the presence and guidance of God.

Wanted: Good leaders

The two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were the trusted priests of the ancient temple in Shiloh. But they were stealing from the temple and committing immoral acts. As a result, the army of Israel was cursed and got hammered by the Philistines. Hophni and Phinehas were slain and the Philistines took the ark of God captive. It is a cautionary tale about the faithful's need for good leaders. Pray for vocations, and very specifically for men and women to serve the Lord in truth and integrity.

Move on

There's a lot in life that can get us down. Sometimes they are things of our own making, and sometimes, well, it's life. It's not always easy to know what to do. We can stand still and try to figure it out, or we can backtrack to see what happened. At some point, however, it is time to move forward—to step out of what happened and to imagine something new. "Begin now," says Saint Jerome, "to be what you will be hereafter."

Alone with the truth

Few of us would take aloneness to the extent of Saint Anthony of the Desert, who spent much of his 105 years in solitude. Stories of Anthony say he was besieged by all kinds of temptations in the desert night. At some level we know that silence forces us to confront the reality of who we are before God. But, as Saint Anthony explains, it is a worthy pursuit: "One who knows oneself, knows God . . . Therefore, my beloveds in the Lord, know yourselves." Opening up at such depth is indeed terrifying, but Jesus "gets" the weakness of being human. He calls each of us not for condemnation but friendship.

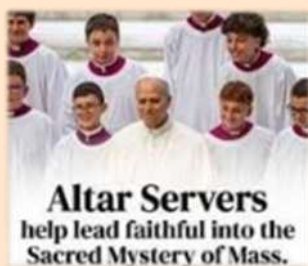

LITURGY OF THE WORD WITH CHILDREN

The next Liturgy of the Word with Children will take place **January 11 and 25** during the 9:00 AM Mass at St. Mary.

LOOKING FORWARD TO OUR PILGRIMAGE OF THE HEART!

As we announced in last week's bulletin, Mother of Sorrows Church will be closed for Mass and liturgical services for eight weeks **beginning on February 1**. We will reopen for Mass on Palm Sunday weekend, **March 28 and 29**.

What's going on and why do we have to close? During this time, we will be expanding the footprint of the sanctuary to provide additional space during Mass for our liturgical ministers. The tabernacle will be moved to the center of the sanctuary behind the altar, and Eucharistic Chapel will become the Chapel of the Holy Family, a devotional space, housing the statues of the Mary, St. Joseph, and the votive candles. The cracked and broken tile flooring of the sanctuary will be replaced, and the carpeting (installed in the 2002 renovation) in the church, narthex and lower narthex will be replaced. The interior of the church and chapel will be repainted.

Where should we go to Mass? Additional Masses will be scheduled at St. Mary in Export and St. John in Delmont. The schedule from the weekend of February 1 – March 27 will be as follows:

What is a pilgrimage? Pilgrimage is one of the Church's most ancient and meaningful traditions—a sacred journey that reflects our deeper spiritual longing for God. Whether walking ancient roads or traveling to a nearby shrines, pilgrims leave behind the routine of daily life to step into a space and time of grace, prayer, and encounter with God. In our Catholic tradition, a pilgrimage is more than a journey to a sacred place - it's a spiritual act of devotion and a response to God's call. It involves traveling to a sacred place with the intention of growing closer to Christ, seeking spiritual renewal, healing, or guidance. It is marked by prayer, sacrifice, and an openness to grace, which is a perfect way to celebrate Lent this year.

PILGRIMAGE OF THE HEART - CONTINUED

We will begin this Pilgrimage of the Heart with a parish mission led by Father Joseph McCaffrey, Episcopal Vicar of the North Vicarate of the Diocese of Pittsburgh on the weekend of January 24 and 25. Fr. McCaffrey will preach at all the Masses at MOS that weekend. On the following Monday and Tuesday, **January 26 and 27**, Fr. McCaffrey will offer two additional evenings of reflection at St. John Parish at 7:00 PM which are open to parishioners from all three of our parishes.

Additional information will be posted in the weekly bulletin and in the weekly emails that are sent to MOS parishioners. Plan to join this **Pilgrimage of the Heart** during Lent and enter into the spiritual transformation that and the celebrate our return throughout the Easter season.

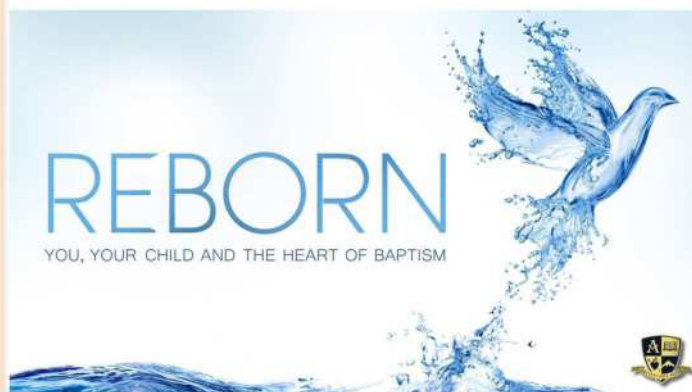

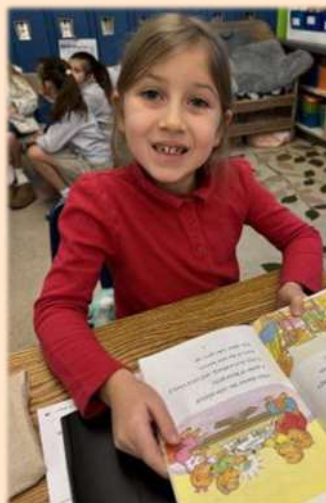
